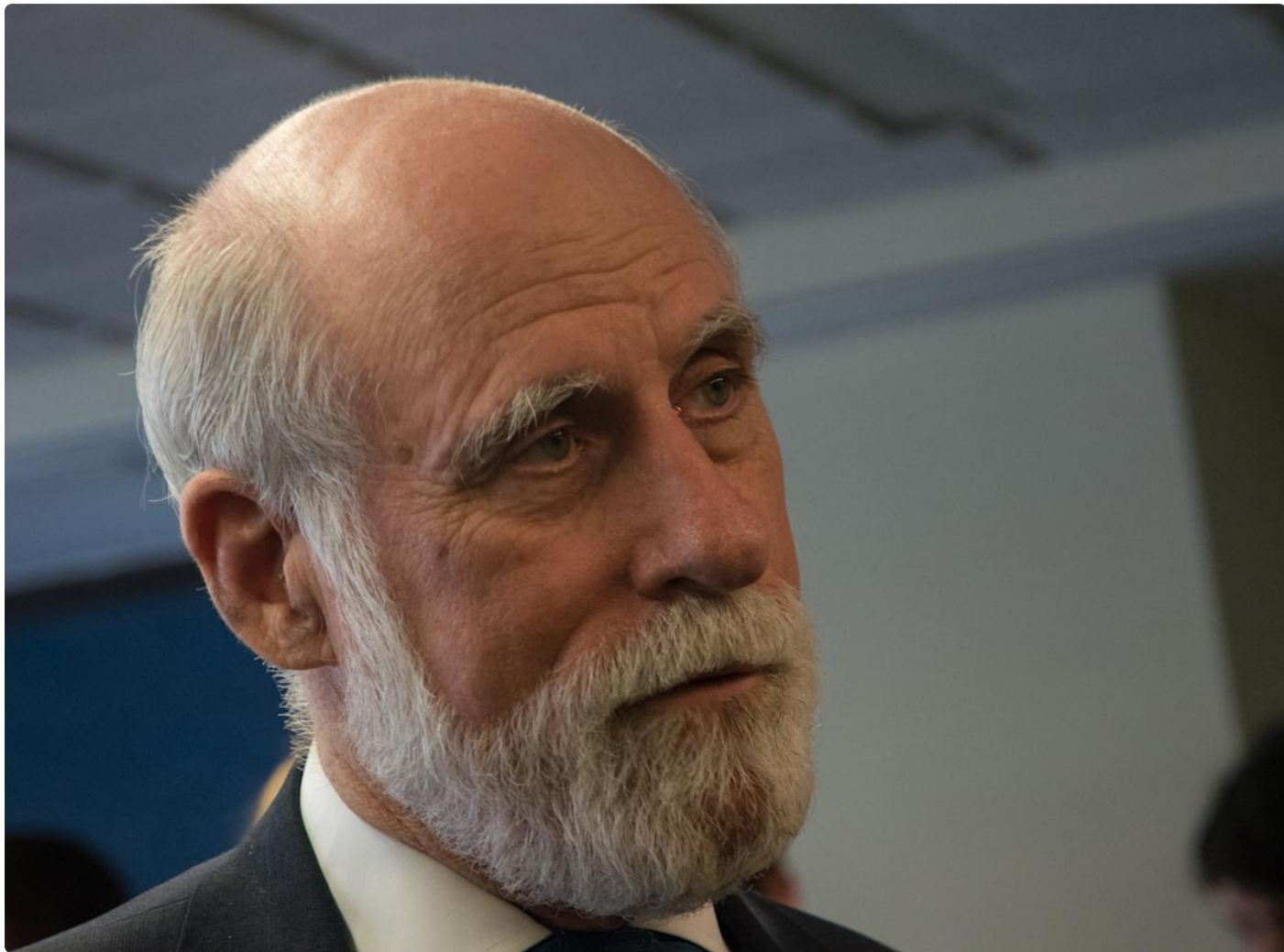


Hall of Fame: Vinton Cerf
